

Year 2 Rashford: Spring 1 Curriculum Map

English

Children will be taught reading and spelling during Phonics sessions using the Read, Write Inc. programme. In English sessions, the children will develop their spelling, punctuation and grammar as well as creating a range of writing pieces linked to the text 'Bob and the Moon Tree Mystery'.



Maths

This half term the children will be focusing on two topics.

They will learn about how to count money, add money and work out change.

They will also begin to learn key multiplication and division strategies.

History

Moon Landing: The children will learn about the 'Space Race' between Russia and America and will learn about why the Apollo 11 moon landing is a significant historical event.



RE

We will be thinking about what commitment means to us and understand that Muslims show commitment through praying at regular intervals each day.

Music

Children will practise their singing and performance skills and creating simple rhythms.

PSHE

Dreams and Goals: The children learn about setting goals, taking small steps to achieve success, working towards shared successes and overcoming obstacles.



Computing

The children will continue to develop their use of the laptops and will follow the 'Maze Explorers' topic.

PE

Children will focus on fundamental skills with PE Coach Lewis. Our PE day is **Tuesday**.
