

Year 2 Rashford Spring 1 Highlights

In English, we have been working on a variety of writing skills using the text 'Bob and the Moon Tree Mystery'. The children created some excellent pieces of writing including their own versions of the story and reports on 'How to Look After a Baby Alien'.



In Maths, we began by working on counting and adding money and working out change. We then began to work on Multiplication and Division strategies, which we will continue to develop in Spring 2.



In Science, we have been learning about everyday materials. Throughout the topic, the children had a great time getting involved in a variety of practical activities, such as testing which materials can be bent and testing which materials are waterproof.



In History, we learnt about the 'Space Race' between Russia and America and the children produced some excellent work linked to the Apollo 11 moon landing.

In Art, we have been working on using paint to mix primary colours and have developed our printing skills. We had some fantastic final pieces of work, inspired by artist Clarice Cliff.



In RE, we learnt about the importance of prayer to Muslims and how it helps them in their everyday life. The children were able to understand the commitment that this takes and could reflect on how they show commitment in their lives.
