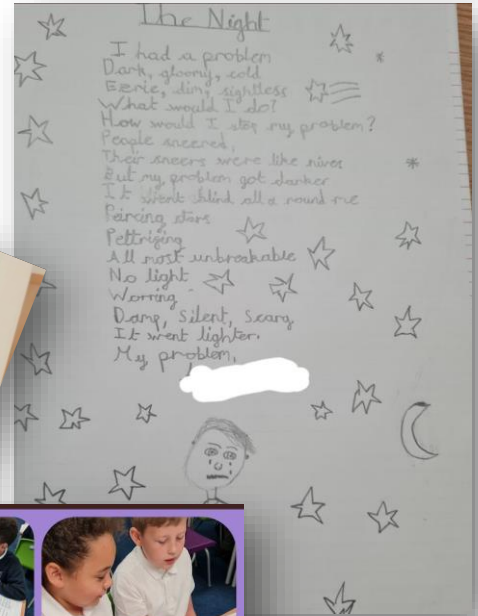
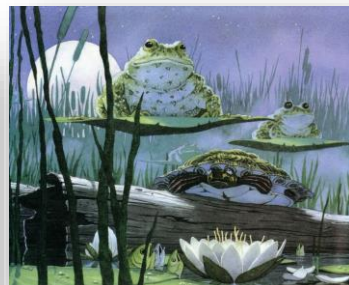
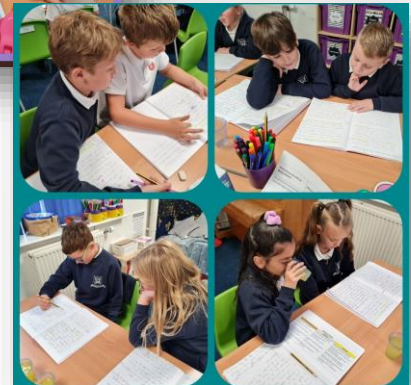


5 Boyle Autumn 1

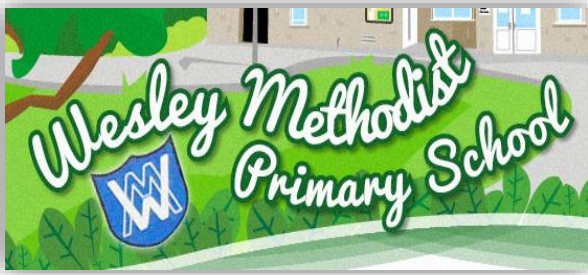
We've made a fantastic start to the year in 5 Boyle. Everyone has worked hard and had lots fun. Here are just a few highlights of this half term.

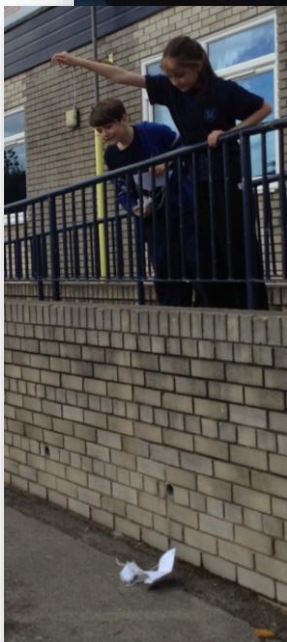
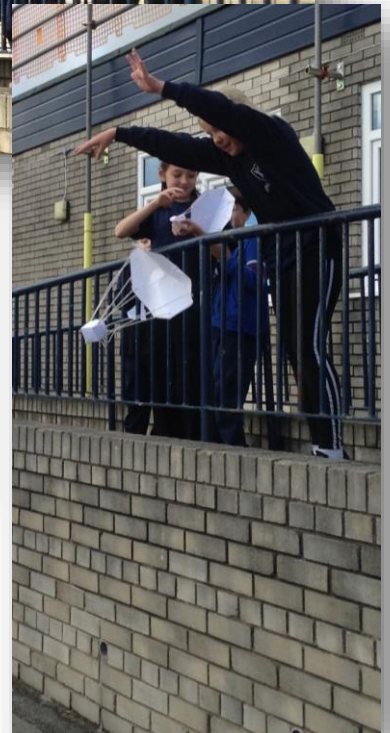

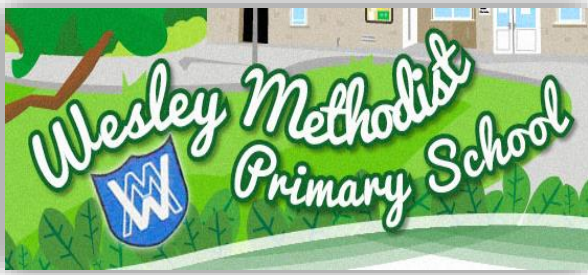


Our science topic this half term has been forces.
