We are excited to announce that we will be offering two new workshops for parents and carers to support key skills in literacy and maths. We have been completing a range of work with Elms Bank this academic year which has opened up the opportunity to run these workshops. These sessions will be delivered by professionals from the Oak Learning Partnership, who will provide valuable insights and strategies to help you support your child's learning at home.

The details of the workshops are as follows:

1. **Literacy Workshop for Parents and Carers of children in Years 1-6**
Date: Thursday 1st May
Time: 2:15pm – 3:15pm
2. **Maths Workshop for Parents and Carers of children in Years 1 and 2**
Date: Thursday 15th May
Time: 2:15pm – 3:15pm

Both workshops will be held at the school, and we encourage all parents and carers to attend if possible.

The literacy workshop will be an introduction to practical strategies to help support your child with phonics, reading and writing. There will be an emphasis on multi-sensory learning and how this can help consolidate concepts taught at school.

The maths workshop will be an introduction to how best support your child and their numeracy skills. It will look at the main principles that underpin math skills (concrete, pictorial, abstract) and discuss practical strategies to support your child with their learning. These sessions will focus on practical tips and activities that you can use to support your child's development in these essential areas.

We look forward to welcoming you to these informative and interactive sessions, and we hope they will provide you with useful tools to enhance your child's learning journey.
