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Dear Parents and Carers,

Upcoming Changes to Classroom Arrangements – Important Information

I am writing to inform you of some upcoming changes to classroom arrangements which will begin to take place this half term. These changes are part of our preparations for the exciting opening of our brand-new nursery, which will launch in the next academic year around January 2026.

To accommodate the new nursery, which will be based in our current Reception classroom, we are beginning the process of transitioning children and staff into new classroom spaces across the school. This will ensure a smooth and settled start to the nursery provision while maintaining continuity and care for our current pupils. The planned changes are as follows:

- Year 3 Garvey will move to the Rainbow Room on the KS2 side of school. This will take place on Thursday 3rd July and drop-off and pick-up for Year 3 Garvey will take place on the main KS2 playground from this date.
- Year 2 will be moving into the current Bubbles Room. This will take place on Thursday 3rd July and Year 2 drop-off and pick-up will take place at the doors towards the back of the school hall.
- Our Year 1 and Year 1/2 classes will also be moving in due course, and we will communicate these changes with parents and carers closer to the time.
- The move of Reception into their new classroom will take place in the Autumn term.

Please be assured that all moves will be supported carefully to ensure children feel confident and secure in their new learning spaces.

The Bubbles provision will continue to run as normal, and usual procedures for drop-off and pick-up for Bubbles children will remain in place.

We thank you for your continued support and understanding as we make these exciting changes to help our school grow and improve for the future. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to speak to your child's class teacher or a member of the senior leadership team.
