PENALTY NOTICES

As a consequence of the Isle of Wight case in May 2016 and the High Court decision, Bury Council made a policy decision at that time to suspend its School Attendance Penalty Notice System. However, this High Court ruling was overturned by the Supreme Court on 6th April 2017. As a result, I am writing to inform you that Bury Council is re-instating its School Attendance Penalty Notice System from September 2017.

In September 2013 changes to legislation meant that Head Teachers were unable to authorise Holidays in Term-Time unless for exceptional circumstances, evidence of which should be provided to the Head Teacher in the first instance. This legislation has not changed.

I must inform you that taking your child/children out of school when a holiday is not authorised, may mean you are issued with a Penalty Notice under Section 23 of the Anti Social Behaviour Act 2003, or face legal action under Section 444 (1) of the Education Act 1996.

Penalty Notices are issued **per parent per child** at £60 each if paid within 21 days rising to £120 each if paid within 28 days. Failure to pay a Penalty Notice will result in the Local Authority taking legal action against you under Section 444 (1) of the Education Act 1996. The maximum penalty for this offence is a fine of up to £1000 per parent per child.
